The Rainforest Festival's Solstice Ephemeral Art Show

June 18, 2022 until it fades back into the landscape...

Ephemeral art is made from objects found in nature and displayed in outdoor settings. It is intentionally made to last for only a temporary period. The processes of nature; wind, waves, rain, and time will change and eventually remove the art piece. Therefore **all art must be made of natural materials** that can degrade or return to the landscape.

* Pieces must be installed on Borough property on the Hungry Point Trail or Outlook Parks (outside the shelters only.)

* Limit three pieces per artist

* To be included in the show, your piece(s) must be pre-approved by Wednesday, June 15. We will work with you to make sure your artwork will not negatively impact the surrounding environment. Please designate the specific location within the areas listed above where you plan to install your art and a list of all materials you'll use. Specific sites will be reserved "first-come, first-served."

* Final artwork should be installed on location June 17.

* Artists will need to submit a photo of their final piece on location on June 17 for a future "virtual" show. The photo(s) should be sent to akrainforestfestival@gmail.com

* Neither the Rainforest Festival nor the Petersburg Borough will be responsible for loss, vandalism or theft of these outdoor artworks on public lands

* Art must be family-friendly and contain no plastic
